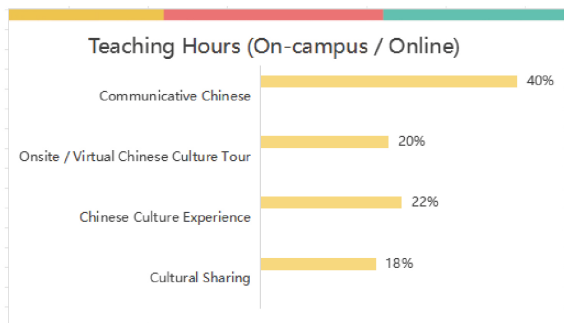

Visa

Students admitted for the on-campus program should apply for a DQ visa (short-term visa) at their Chinese embassy/consulate using the provided admission letter.

Application

1. Program fee

(1) On-campus program:

- ◆ USD 1000/person

The fee covers tuition, on-campus accommodation, teaching materials, insurance, field trips .

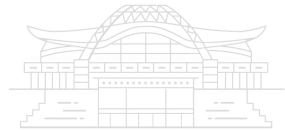
(2) Online program:

- ◆ Free for students from partner university
- ◆ USD 280/person for others

2. Application Deadline

November 30, 2023 (On-campus program)

December 24, 2023 (Online program)

4. Qualification

(1) On-campus program:

- ◆ Non-Chinese citizen.
- ◆ Has a minimum score of 180 in HSK (Chinese Proficiency Test) Level 3.
- ◆ Has an interest in Chinese language and culture.

(2) Online program:

- ◆ Non-Chinese citizen.
- ◆ Primarily designed for students who either lack foundational knowledge in Chinese or at the initial stages of learning pinyin, common Chinese words and sentences.
- ◆ Has an interest in Chinese language and culture.

5. Nomination

Nomination are required from partner universities.
